DIVISION 2. LICENSING AND REGISTRATION

Sec. 90.055 LICENSE

(A) *Required; term; prerequisites; fee.*

- (1) No person group of persons, or business entity in the municipality may own, keep or harbor more than 3 dogs of 3 month of age or older, without obtaining a kennel license.
- (2) Any person operating a kennel must obtain a nontransferable kennel license, which shall be posted in a conspicuous place in kennel. A kennel license shall expire on December 31 of each year and shall be renewed by February 1 of the following year. No kennel license may be issued without an inspection certificate issued by the Animal Control Officer. The annual kennel license fee shall be \$25.00.

(B) *Denials, suspensions, and revocations.*

- (1) A kennel license may be denied, suspended, or revoked by the Animal Control Officer upon a determination that the operator of the kennel or pet store is in violation of this chapter.
- (2) An opportunity for a hearing on a denial, suspension, or revocation shall be provided at a time and a place determined by the City Commission.
- (3) Based upon the record of the hearing, the Commission shall make a finding and shall sustain, modify, or rescind the action considered at the hearing. Any owner of a kennel or pet store whose license has been suspended or revoked may make application for the reinstatement of the license. If, following inspection, the applicant has complied with the requirements of this chapter, the license shall be reinstated.
